EOTC Achievements

EOTC's capacity to effectively implement major public-private initiatives is further evidenced in **EOTC**-designed and research-based programs that have received national and statewide recognition. Some of these programmatic accomplishments are:

- A neighborhood-based parenting program that became a Pennsylvania Governor's Model.
- The region's first open-entry job search center, pre-dating the CareerLink system.
- A decade as the region's only Fatherhood Initiative.
- Educational programming for local offenders that received successive state and federal demonstration grants.
- The Stepping Up program was twice featured at the International Conference of Prison Educators.
- Innovative youth mentoring and teen parenting services in collaboration with local schools, court programs and the Children and Youth agency.
